

## MONTHLY ACTIVATION VOUCHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS



The following Terms and Conditions apply to the “Vic Kids Eat Well rewards – Monthly Activation Voucher”.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

These terms and conditions include information on how to enter the Vic Kids Eat Well– Monthly Activation Voucher (**Competition**) and details of prizes (**Terms and Conditions**). Participation in the Competition constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. Only entries that are submitted and comply with the below Terms and Conditions may take part in this Competition.

The Promoter is Cancer Council Victoria, 200 Victoria Parade, East Melbourne Victoria 3002 (**Promoter**), as part of the Vic Kids Eat Well Program. The Vic Kids Eat Well Program is supported by the Victorian Government and delivered by the Promoter.

This Competition is running between 1 December 2025 to 28 February 2026 (**Competition Period**). During the Competition Period, each promotional period commences on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, 00:00:01am AEST and closes on the last date of each month, 11:59:59pm AEST (each, a **Promotional Period**).

To be eligible for this Competition, an organisation must be a current Vic Kids Eat Well member organisation, operate in Victoria, provide/sell food and drink to young people between the ages of 5 and 18 and have not previously completed a Vic Kids Eat Well Food and Drink Survey (baseline) (**Organisation Eligibility Requirements**).

Any new Vic Kids Eat Well Food and Drink Survey (baseline) that includes a response to the competition question and is submitted by an organisation or their health promoter during a Promotional Period that complies with these Terms and Conditions will be automatically entered into the monthly Vic Kids Eat Well Activation Voucher Competition draw.

An organisation can only submit one food and drink survey during their membership.

Organisations that do not wish to participate can opt-out by:

- a) selecting the opt-out tick box in the Vic Kids Eat Well food and drink survey (baseline survey) themselves or through their health promoter; or
- b) emailing [vickidseatwell@cancervic.org.au](mailto:vickidseatwell@cancervic.org.au) with the organisation’s full name and a request to opt out.

## To enter this Competition:

1. Persons must be a registered Vic Kids Eat Well organisation or health promotion professional and submit a baseline survey including an answer to the competition question ‘In 100 words or less, tell us how your organisation would use a \$150 Kitchen Warehouse voucher to foster a healthy food and drink environment for kids’ on behalf of a registered Vic Kids Eat Well member organisation that meets the Organisation Eligibility Requirements.
  2. Only one baseline entry is permitted per organisation. Any additional entries will be considered invalid. Each organisation is eligible to win the Activation voucher only once. Incomplete, indecipherable or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid.
  3. The Promoter’s decision in relation to any aspect of this Competition is final and binding. No correspondence will be entered into.
  4. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry where it reasonably suspects that such materials are prohibited by these Terms and Conditions, any relevant law, or otherwise deemed inappropriate. This is at the Promoter's absolute discretion and discussions will not be entered into. Entries that are considered unlawful, harassing, defamatory, abusive, threatening, harmful, obscene, profane, sexually orientated, racially offensive, contain objectionable content or are otherwise inappropriate will not be deemed valid and will be rejected.
  5. By entering this Competition, entrants consent to receipt of emails from the Promoter regarding this Competition, and other emails from the Promoter which inform the entrant of the Promoter's other publications, products, services and events and promote relevant third-party goods and services. You can unsubscribe from these communications at any time.
  6. By entering this Competition, the organisation provides the Promoter with permission to reproduce and use the organisation’s name for purposes associated with promoting Vic Kids Eat Well (such as, on social media platforms, website).
- 1** This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winners. Each entry will be individually judged based on the merit of the information provided. The selection criteria of “identifying how the organisation will use the voucher”, will take into consideration:
- how the proposed use aligns with Vic Kids Eat Well actions,
  - how it enables access to nutritious food and drink options,
  - how it is supporting equitable access to nutritious food and drink options,
  - how it fosters inclusion across diverse community settings.

The winner entry will be determined by the Vic Kids Eat Well team at the offices of the Promoter. Judging will take place in the first two weeks of every month by the Vic Kids Eat Well team. There will be one winner per month.

7. The Promoter’s [privacy policy](#) applies to this Competition.
8. The Promoter will keep records of this Competition for 3 years.

## Prizes:

9. There will be one Activation voucher winner chosen each month during the **Competition Period**. Each prize is a \$150 Kitchen Warehouse e-voucher.
10. The prize winners will be notified by email by the 15th of each month, and prizes will be sent by the last day of the month.
11. If, in any event, a potential competition winner does not want to accept the prize, or the Promoter is unable to locate a winner by 5pm on the last day of the following month to when the bite was submitted, the prize will be forfeited by the winner, with no liability whatsoever on the Promoter towards the prize winner. Another winner will then be selected by the Promoter following the notification requirements as per these Terms and Conditions.
12. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for any other form of compensation (including cash), unless otherwise specified. The value of the prizes is accurate as at the commencement of the Competition Period. The Promoter and its associated parties accept no responsibility for any variation in the value of a prize after that date.
